### **Sussex Coast Shoreham to Telscombe 1797**

2 inches to a mile (1: 31680) - British Library

Pen and ink by Thomas Budgen dated 1797

Shows houses of Hove Drove (later Hove Street) and the parish church standing in fields to the North East. Though not identified as such, the map shows the parish boundary of Hove.

Six inches to one mile (1: 10560) - National Library of Scotland

Shows Portslade, Aldrington, Hangleton, West Blatchington and western Hove parish.

**Ordnance Survey Sheet 318 - Brighton (Outline) Publication date: 1895**

One inch to a mile (1: 63360) - National Library of Scotland

Small scale. Shows the streets of Hove that were developed by then but does not actually name the town as Hove though West Blatchington, Hangleton and Toads Hole are named. Dotted line indicates the position of the Hove parish boundary.

**Ordnance Survey Sheet 318 - Brighton (Hills) Publication date: 1895**

One inch to a mile (1: 63360) - National Library of Scotland

Shows similar small scale detail to the Outline map (above) plus an indication of hills. This map does name the town of Hove.

**Sussex LXV.SE (Aldrington; Hove; Portslade by Sea; Southwick.) Revised: 1896**

Six inches to one mile (1: 10560) - National Library of Scotland

Narrow coastal strip, south of the south coast railway. reaches only as far east at Grand Avenue. Shows winding Hove Street and the narrow constrictions in Church Road.
